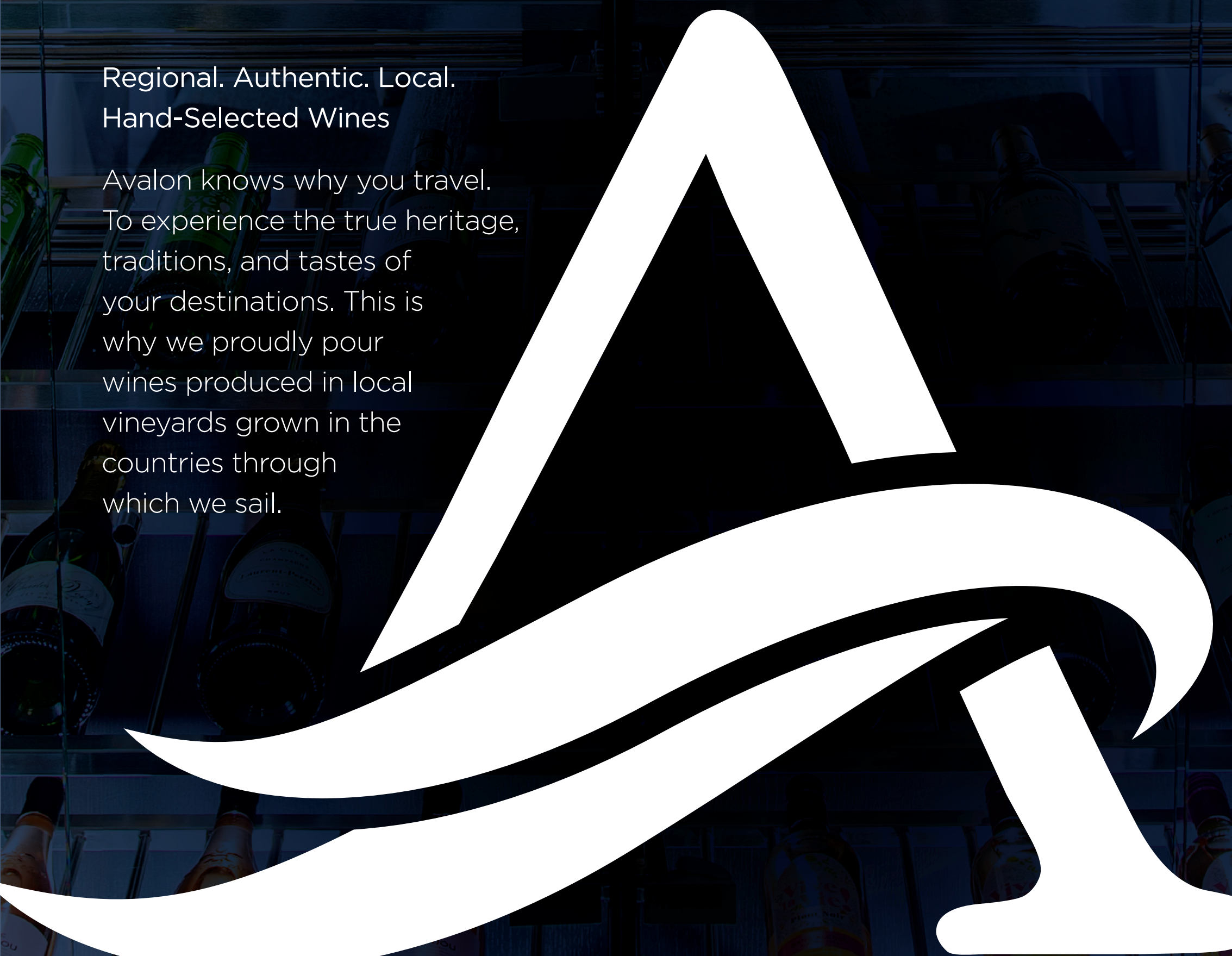

*Character Fine spicy nose, fruit tones of mango and pineapple, nuts full-bodied on the palate, with a strong body, juicy, ripe acidity. Fruity, sweet and animating with a long finish.*

#### Gruner Veltliner

Höpler – Austria – 13% vol.

*Light yellow-green Aromas of green apple and lime Ripe citrus fruit*

#### Grüner Veltliner

Lentsch – Austria – 11% vol.

*The nose combines aromas of stone fruit with green apples. On the palate, the Austrian classic is fresh and lively.*

### BULGARIA

#### Bergulé Viognier & Chardonnay

Villa Melnik – Bulgaria – 12% vol.

*Complex and fresh nose with notes of sweet grapefruit, orange and melon. Fruity and juicy, fine and round, harmonious in the finish.*

*Beautiful bright colour with green reflections. Notes of exotic fruits, fresh and silky palate with a beautiful aromatic length.*

#### Sauvignon Blanc

*Beautiful, fresh and light; perfect with oysters peach notes, not too citrusy, woody, easy drinkable.*

#### Château de Cathalogne

Château de Cathalogne – 13% vol.

*Aroma of ripe lemon and exotic fruit. This dry white wine has a strong and elegant taste. Perfect for seafood, white meat and aperitifs.*

Chemins des Papes - 12.5 % vol.

*Clear straw yellow with silver reflections. Intense aromas of flowers, aniseed plant and white fruit. An attack rich in alcohol, a smooth wine with delicate, complex scents.*

### Côtes du Rhône Blanc AOC

Chemins des Papes - France - 13.5% vol.

*The Côtes du Rhône Blanc fascinates with its invigorating aroma of juicy apricots combined with crunchy apples and an impressive background of fresh flowers.*

### French Dog Blanc

Côtes de Gascogne France - 11.5% vol.

*The French Dog has an intense bouquet. Lime and lemon alternate with delicate mineral notes. Very lively and thirst-quenching on the palate.*

### Syrius Blanc

Domaine Clavel - France - 14% vol.

*The Syrius Blanc is a bright straw color that seduces with aromas of elderflowers, pears and melons.*

### Languedoc Picpoul de Pinet

Domaine de la Madone - France - 13% vol.

*The bouquet of the Languedoc Picpoul de Pinet delivers a fruity scent of tangy lemon, juicy mango, melon and fresh peach.*

### Blanc Viognier

Fiancée Duroc - France - 13% vol.

*Made from the aromatic Viognier grape variety, the Fiancée Duroc white wine delights with fine fruit and delicate spice. The short stay in oak barrels give it extra creaminess.*

### Sauvignon Val de Loire

Marcel Martin la Perclaire - France - 13% vol.

*Aromas of exotic fruits combine with black currant and a hint of mint, while the fine minerality and freshness.*

### Chardonnay Val de Loire AOC

Marquis de Goulaine - France - 12% vol.

*This Chardonnay impresses with its artistic aromas of sparkling citrus fruit, showcasing an excellent mineral freshness with finesse.*

### Fleur de Cantelys

Sauvignon Blanc | Sémillon - 13% vol.

*This white wine, very fresh, offers great tension with beautiful fruitiness.*

### Bourgogne Blanc AOP

Victor Bérard Burgund - France - 12.5% vol.

*Matured on its own yeasts, this slightly creamy, rich and aromatic wine presents itself harmoniously with varied notes of ripe fruits, delicate flowers and hazelnuts.*

## GERMANY

### Riesling trocken VDP.Gutswein

Allendorf - Germany - 12.5% vol.

*A typical Rheingau Riesling. Racy acidity, grippy finish and with delicate fruit.*

### Prinz zur Lippe

Cuvée - Germany - 12.5% vol.

*Very much clear yellow fruit, citrus, ripe peach and apple. On the palate mineral, fruity straightforward with lots of melting and wonderfully quaffable finish.*

### Riesling Kabinett

Hochheimer Daubhaus - Germany - 11% vol.

*Elegant in the nose, the Riesling Kabinette convinces on the palate with a delicate, fruity sweetness and a perfectly balanced acidity.*

### Chardonnay

Moselland - Germany - 12% vol.

*This lovely Chardonnay smells of banana, guava, ripe apple, and mango, while mineral notes, a hint of white pepper, and ethereal herbs crown the bouquet.*

### Rietburger Chardonnay

Moselland - Germany - 12.5% vol.

*This young Chardonnay shows scents of gooseberries and exotic fruits. Enjoy it with light dishes, fish and seafood.*

### Saar Riesling Kabinett

Moselland - Germany - 9% vol.

*With its fresh bouquet of crisp green apples and juicy citrus fruits, it guarantees a harmonious melange between grape sweetness and fruit acidity.*

### Pinot Blanc

### Chardonnay

Kovacs Nimrod – Hungary – 13.5% vol.

*This unoaked fresh and crispy chardonnay sourced from our excellent terroirs near Noszvaj demonstrates why the chardonnay is well loved around the world.*

### Dixie

Kovacs Nimrod – Hungary – 13% vol.

*The mineral rich reductive Pinot Gris is married with the less aged and barrel-matured Chardonnay. The harmony of the two French varieties, reminds us the magic of Dixie and New Orleans.*

## ITALY

### Bianco

Gran Appasso – Italy – 13% vol.

*This white wine from Chardonnay and Fiano smells seductively of ripe yellow fruit, juicy vineyard peach, crisp gooseberry, lime zest and mint.*

### Barbanera

Gigino G´ Bianco – Italy – 12.5% vol.

*With a strong body and creamy feel, the Barbanera's sweet accents, grippy fruit acid and juicy overflow inspire, providing pure drinking pleasure.*

### Pinot Grigio

Viso di Vino – Italy – 12% vol.

*Fresh, fruity aromas of pineapple, papaya, guava, passion fruit, honeydew melon and mineral nuances rush into the nose.*

## PORTUGAL

### Flor Do Côa

Costa Boal – Portugal – 13% vol.

*Citric Colour, fine flower aromas and tropical fruit, mouthfeel shows refreshing with a good acidity and a intense and pleasant final.*

### Douro Planalto Reserva

Casa Ferreirinha – Portugal – 12,5% vol.

*A bright-greenish colour with golden tints. Floral tones and notes of white and citrus fruit and tropical fruit. On the palate, it has a refreshing acidity and elegant finish.*

### Soalheiro Alvarinho

Quinta de Soalheiro – Portugal – 12% vol.

*Bright, lemon-yellow colour. Fresh and elegant fragrance, intense tropical and mineral notes that balance perfectly with the acidity.*

### Encosta Do Sobral Chardonnay

Santos & Seixo – Portugal – 13.5% vol.

*Citrine color, reminiscent of pineapple and peach combined with light vanilla and mineral. Elegant, fresh, unctuous and with a long aftertaste.*

### Encosta Do Sobral Selection

Santos & Seixo – Portugal – 13.5% vol.

*Open straw citrine color, intense aroma of fresh fruit and notes of vanilla. Fresh and elegant with a long finish.*

### Alentejano Vicentino

Vicentino – Portugal – 12% vol.

*This white wine displays a remarkable freshness. Blend of original varieties, extremely pleasant and refreshing wine.*

## ROMANIA

### Chardonnay

Domeniile Mitroi – Murfatlar, Romania – 13% vol.

*Young poetry, once spoken, will leave you, as an echo, subtle memories of limes, gooseberries, quince and melon. A poem that wants to be reread.*

### Feteasca Regala

La Crama – Romania – 12.5% vol.

*Is a semi-dry white wine, fresh and with fruity taste. This wine is served well chilled, and goes very well with fish dishes, with poultry steaks or desserts.*

### Sauvignon Blanc

La Crama – Romania – 13% vol.

*This delightful Sauvignon Blanc flows into the glass a bright yellow with green reflections, and classic aromas of meaty lemon fillets, delicate elderflowers and violets.*

### Sauvignon Blanc 3 Hectare

Murfatlar – Romania - 12.5% vol.

*The wine offers a medium, persistent acidity, a fine balance between fruit and mineral character, complemented by a persistent pomelo finish.*

## SERBIA

### Villa Nota Chardonnay

Pik Oplenac – Serbia - 12% vol.

*Of bright yellow/greenish color, strong fruity character with a hint of banana, exotic fruits, apples, citrus fruits.*

### Belos

Vinarium – Serbia - 12.5% vol.

*Dominant traminac aromas (honey, mango and white flowers). Suave, nice acidity, balanced and refreshing.*

## SLOVAKIA

### Pinot Blanc - Pro Rege

Viajur – Slovakia - 12.5% vol.

*The aroma of vanilla, citrus, bread crust and acacia honey suggests that this is a more serious wine. The taste is medium full-bodied, slightly creamy.*

## SPAIN

### El Vergal

Bodegas San Gregorio – Spain - 15% vol.

*The El Vergal Cervera de la Ca'ada immediately captivates with its dense cherry-red color and bright edges.*

## AUSTRIA

### Zweigelt

Alphart – Austria – 13% vol.

*The full-bodied Zweigelt is characterized by a shiny, ruby-red color, offering hints of cherries and blackberries, wild fruit on the palate and a long finish.*

### Cabernet Franc

Alfred Fischer – Austria – 14% vol.

*Cherry-red with a dark core, the Hungarian Cabernet Franc conjures images of dark forest berries, leaves, carnations, and undergrowth.*

### K7

Höpler - Austria – 13.5% vol.

*You can't help but enjoy this high quality, premium red cuvée. K7 appeals to a young, modern and cosmopolitan palate.*

## BULGARIA

### Tradition Cuvee Bergulé

Villa Melnik – Bulgaria - 14.5% vol.

*Deep ruby color, elegant nose with blackcurrant notes, pepper and leather. Light to medium body with medium, smoky aftertaste.*

## FRANCE

### Syrah

Cave du Tain - 12.5 % vol.

*A supple, fruity Syrah, perfect for everyday drinking. Aromas of red fruit and spices, fine tannins. Ideal with cold meats or simple dishes.*

### Delphis de La Dauphine

Château de la Dauphine – 13.5% vol.

*It has as a deep brick-red colour with a hint of wild cherries. A well-balanced, medium-bodied wine, mellow on the palate with fruit and raisin flavours.*

### St. Emilion Vieux

Château des Combes - 15% vol.

*Very good and intensive fruity nose, full body on the mouth, balanced structure of ripen blackberry, cherry, oaky and vanilla. Tannin is very tight.*

### Merlot | Cabernet Sauvignon

Château Haut Mouleyre – 13.5% vol.

*complex and fruity nose with pleasant violet and vanilla aromas. On the palate this wine is rich, well balanced and persistent with notes of red fruit and coffee.*

### Merlot | Cabernet Sauvignon

Château Les Grands Vallons - 13.5% vol.

*Medium ruby coloured with a nose of dark cherries and dark plums. Full bodied with a fruit forward palate. Medium plus tannins and medium acidity.*

### Haut Medoc Cru Bourgeois

Château Lestage - 14.5% vol.

*The tertiary aromas of cedar, truffle, leather and dried black cherry have a pleasant intensity. A solid acidic and persistent column, fine-grained tannins.*

### Bergerac Rouge

Château Mautain - 14% vol.

*This wine is an elegant, bold red with herbal dark blackcurrant and plum notes, accented by hints of cedar, and soft, pliable tannins rounding out the palate.*

### Cotes de Bourg

Château Peychaud - 13.5% vol.

*Dark in color, this is a bold, spicy wine. It has firm tannins that contrast well with the dense black fruits and acidity. Rich and with a fine smoky aftertaste.*

### Côtes du Rhône Rouge AOC

Chemins des Papes - France - 13% vol.

*In the glass, the Côtes du Rhône Rouge is a nice cherry red with violet reflections. In the nose, notes of fruit and spice come through, with a gripping taste and a juicy end.*

### Régulus Rouge Côtes du Rhône

Domaine Clavel - France - 13% vol.

*In the glass, the Régulus Rouge is a beautiful cherry-red color, with aromas of cherries, strawberries, and pepper.*

### Black Gorilla

Domaine Guinand - France - 15% vol.

*This Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon cuvée glows in the glass with intense purple and a palette of delectable aromas.*

### Rouge Fitou AOP

Domaine Sainte Anne - 14% vol.

*Ideal with baked sheep cheese parcels or fried veal liver with apples, this red wine is a culinary highlight. Notes of minerals, Chamomile, smoky, Black tea.*

### Gorilla King

Languedoc - France - 13.5% vol.

*The Gorilla King flows into the glass a dense ruby red, exuding aromas of delicate spice and intense fruits such as sour cherries, juicy blackberries and aromatic blueberries.*

### Provence Premiere Rouge

Pigoudet Aix - France - 13% vol.

*The ruby core of the Provence Premiere Rouge inspires, while the fruity, cool nose shows aromas of bromine, raspberry, cassis, forest air, black pepper and a touch of menthol.*

### Beaujolais

Victor Bérard - France - 13% vol.

*This fruity, harmonious Beaujolais delivers hearty, juicy cherry flavors balanced with a nice acidity.*

### Côtes du Rhône AOC

Victor Bérard - France - 13.5% vol.

*This brilliant, clear ruby red greets with intense aromas of blackberries, red currants and strawberries, and a rounded and fiery palate of delicate spice.*

### Cabernet Sauvignon

Voiturette - France - 14% vol.

*The scent of black currant and stewed paprika settles on the nose.*

### Merlot

Voiturette - France - 13% vol.

*Bouquet of dark plums, sun-ripened blackberries and cherries, accented by subtle, light herbal notes.*

## GERMANY

### Allendorf Spätburgunder

Allendorf - Germany - 13% vol.

*The Pinot Noir offers a bright, light red color in the glass. In the glass, this red wine reveals aromas of strawberries and raspberries, complemented by red currants.*

## HUNGARY

### Rhapsody Egri Bikavér

Kovács Nimród - Hungary - 13.5% vol.

*The unique voices of the Kékfrankos, Pinot Noir, Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Franc, blueberries, ripe harmonious aromas and flavors of cherry and spicy oak like a real rhapsody.*

### Soul Syrah

Kovacs Nimrod - Hungary - 14%

*Our Soul Syrah shows complex spiced notes paired excellent fruits, ripe, flavoured, good vintage*

## ITALY

### Cabernet Sauvignon

Crudo Nero d'Avola - Italy - 14% vol.

*On the palate, this medium-weight Cabernet Sauvignon is complemented by juicy fruitiness, with delicate and noticeable tanins.*

### Primitivo le Vignate

Femar Vini Primitivo le Vignate - Italy - 13% vol.

*Blackberries, blueberries and forest-berry jam set the tone for the Primitivo le Vignate, whose palate is intense and powerful with a smooth polished tannin.*

### Rosso Passito

Gran Appasso - Italy - 13% vol.

*This composition of sour cherries, plums and cranberries in dark chocolate is beguilingly encased in hints of dried herbs, crushed piment and curry leaf.*

## PORTUGAL

### Douro Carm Reserva

CARM - Portugal - 14% vol.

*Fresh and intense with notes of wild black fruits and black cherries balanced with seductive hints of licorice. Subtle notes of wood make the aroma more complex.*

### Douro Papa Figos

Casa Ferreirinha - Portugal - 13.5% vol.

*Ruby colour, intense aroma with balsamic notes of resin, cedar and tobacco box, red fruits and spicy hints of pepper and nutmeg. Smooth with a well-integrated acidity, round and silky tannins and elegant finish.*

### Vinha Grande

Casa Ferreirinha - Portugal - 14,5% vol.

*It offers aromas of ripe dark fruits such as blackberries and plums, hints of spices, herbs, and floral notes. Well-structured, with velvety tannins and a balanced acidity.*

### Quinta Dos Termos

Quinta Dos Termos - Portugal - 13% vol.

*Very intense red colour, with bluish hints, which ensures its longevity. On the nose, it reveals red fruits, with pleasant vanilla notes. Fine tannins, with some plum jam standing out.*

### Douro Quinta Dos Acipreste

Real Companhia Velha - Portugal - 14% vol.

*Beautiful red shows a clean, deep garnet colour. Notes of ripe red plums, mature cherries and red berries. Elegant wine, with a round yet muscular structure and soft taninins.*

### Encosta Do Sobral Selection

Santos & Seixo - Portugal - 13.5% vol.

*Bright red color, balsamic and red fruit aromas. In the mouth balanced, smooth, with tannins present, persistent and deep aftertaste.*

## ROMANIA

### Byzantium Rosso

Dealul Mare - Romania - 13% vol.

*Intensely fragrant bouquet dominated by ripe red fruits. Rich aromas of well-ripened cherries, red berries and plums, complemented by a fine blend of sweet spices.*

### Cabernet Sauvignon Rose

Domeniile Mitroi - Murfatlar, Romania - 12% vol.

*A floral portrait, mineralized with fresh red fruits and vegetal aromas, Cabernet Sauvignon Rose is friendly, rich and always pleasant. Travel with the scent of strawberry, soft rose, slightly peppery orange.*

### Feteasca Neagra

Murfatlar - Romania - 14% vol.

*Complex aromas of plums, black currants, and black cherries, enriched with distinctive woody notes of cedar and oak. Strong taste of blackberry, vanilla, and caramel, with firm tannins.*

## SERBIA

### Monarh Cabernet Sauvignon

Pik Oplenac - Serbia - 13.5% vol.

*Nutty, cream, smoke, oak, clove, dark fruit. Dry, tannic and soft. Dry, tannic and soft.*

### Dedovac

Vinarium - Serbia - 14% vol.

*Nice combination of Black Tamjanika, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon with medium tanins. Nice aroma of cranberry and blueberry.*

## SLOVAKIA

### Frankovka Modrá

Château Topolcianky - Slovakia - 11.5% vol.

*This complex bouquet of wild berry, fine cedarwood, dried cherry and black currant is spicy, with depth and a long finish.*

### Dunaj Ars in Vino

Viajur - Slovakia - 12.5% vol.

*In the aroma, it has a distinctive trace of plum jam and dark chocolate. In the full and rich taste, there is a wonderful harmony of fruit taste with pleasant tannins.*

## SPAIN

### El Vergal

Bodegas San Gregorio - Spain - 15% vol.

*The El Vergal Cervera de la Ca'ada immediately captivates with its dense cherry-red color and bright edges.*

### Grenache

San Gregorio las Martas - Spain - 15% vol.

*This Grenache impresses immediately with its shiny, ruby-red color and bouquet covering a whole range of aromas.*

### Zweigelt Rosé

Bründlmayer - Austria - 12.5% vol.

*The Bründlmayer Zweigelt Rosé seduces with its delicate pink color and combination of fresh raspberries and ripe strawberries that flatter the nose.*

### Rosé Celestia

Höpler - Austria - 13.5% vol.

*Célestia enchants the palate like a precious rose, carasses the spirit and seduces the connoisseur with soft light pink color. Elegant and crisp. Characterised by peppercorns, with a lively, spirited acidity.*

## BULGARIA

### Rosé Bergulé

Villa Melnik - Bulgaria - 12% vol.

*Fresh and elegant wine with pale pink color with dust nuances.*

## FRANCE

### Château Haut Mouleyre Rosé

Bordeaux - France - 12.5% vol.

*Aroma of red berries, herbs and spices and a good tannic and acid structure.*

### Agassante

Château D'agassac - 13% vol.

*Light salmon pink, refreshing and fruity, complex range of flavours reveals on tasting of crushed strawberry, citrus and exotic fruit, blackcurrant buds.*

### Cuvee Scooter

Chateau d'Arsac - 12% vol.

*Citrus, stone fruit and tropical hints in the nose. Slightly acidic rose wine with a good structure and smooth in the mouth.*

### Bordeaux Rosé

Château de la Dauphine - 12.5% vol.

*A brilliant pale pink color. An expressive, aromatic nose with notes of exotic fruit, lychee and pear. Also notes of white flowers such as jasmine and lily.*

### Rose De Desmirail

Château Desmirail - 13% vol.

*It has fresh, fruity is made from Cabernet-Sauvignon and Merlot. An excellent wine to drink as an aperitif and with light summer dishes.*

### Rose De Malleret

Château Malleret - 13.5% vol.

*Pale pink color, sweet aromas, citrus, freshness. An inviting, floral, well-balanced wine with good sapidity.*

### French Dog Rosé

Côtes de Gascogne - France - 12% vol.

*The French Dog has an intense bouquet. Lime and lemon alternate with delicate mineral notes. Very lively and thirst-quenching on the palate.*

### Pinot Noir Rosé

Domaine de la Baume Rosé - France - 13% vol.

*This Pinot Noir Rosé is a particularly soft and fruity representative that is elegant, light, and wonderfully drinkable as it glides over the tongue.*

### Château Pigoudet

La Chapelle Rosé - 13% vol.

*Classic provençal rose. ripe red fruit, easy drinking, citrus notes, low acidity.*

### Rosé d'Anjou la Jaglerie

Marcel Martin - France - 10.5% vol.

*Strawberry-red with ruby reflections, the Rosé d'Anjou la Jaglerie boasts aromas of strawberries and juicy peaches, with a crisp fruit acidity and concentrated cherry finish.*

Allendorf - Germany - 12% vol.

*The Pinot Noir rosé shows a bright, ruby red color in the wine glass. This rosé wine reveals wonderfully expressive aromas of peach, apricot and pear, rounded off by other fruity nuances.*

### Rosé

Kesselring - Germany - 12.5% vol.

*The Kesselring Rosé presents itself with a light pomegranate pink, a fine perlage, flowery and spicy notes, and black currant, blueberry, raspberry and passion fruit.*

*The fruitiness hidden behind the palet and the rosé color provides real refreshment either as an accompaniment to an elegant dinner or on a warm summer evening.*

*Enjoy a lush bouquet of freshly-picked raspberries, juicy strawberries, spicy wild strawberries, plump cherries and a touch of rhubarb.*

*Very appealing and bright hue. It is a fresh and seductive wine with fine and intense bouquet. Well balanced and tempting wine, brilliantly soft and slightly fizzy finish.*
