WALTZ ALONG THE DANUBE ... A NEW STORYTELLER CRUISE WITH AUTHOR CHRISTOPHER MOORE

Fans interested in joining Moore on the Danube River, where Rieslings and pilsners flow, will experience two full days in Vienna in the settings that set the stage for Moore's book, plus the unrivaled music and art – and the coffee houses – where creative geniuses have converged for more than a century. They'll also be privy to special gatherings with Moore – on board their award-winning Suite Ship – and on shore throughout their week together.
